ON THE APPLICATIONS of the defendants Fraser Health Authority and Matthew Wu filed July 2, 2025, and July 16, 2025 coming on for hearing at New Westminster, B.C., on July 30, 2025 and on hearing Eric Stanger, lawyer for Fraser Health Authority and Matthew Wu, and Alicia Catalano, counsel for Dr. McGowan and Dr. Garvida, and Peter Cape on his own behalf, and no one appearing for Dr. John Azer, Foothills Medical Clinic, although duly served, and no one appearing for Dr. McKay and Providence Health Care Rapid Access Specialist Clinic although duly served;


THIS COURT ORDERS that:

1. Within fourteen (14) days of receipt by the plaintiff of this Order, the plaintiff shall produce for delivery to Eric Stanger, counsel for Fraser Health Authority any photographic evidence in the plaintiff's possession, including the two photos shown to Eric Stanger at the New Westminster Courthouse on June 12, 2025; and
2. The defendant FHA and Matthew Wu's application for an order at paragraph 2 of the Notice of Application filed July 2, 2025 is dismissed; and

3. Within fourteen (14) days of receipt by Dr. Rhonda Jane McKay and/or Providence Health Care Rapid Access Specialist Clinic of this Order, Dr. Rhonda McKay and/or Providence Health Care Rapid Access Specialist Clinic shall produce for delivery to Eric Stanger, counsel for Fraser Health Authority all clinical records from July 1, 2023 to present relating the present to be accompanied by a covering letter. The applicant will provide the plaintiff with a copy of the documents received within fourteen (14) days of receipt.
4. The defendant FHA and Matthew Wu's application for an order at paragraph 4 of the Notice of Application filed July 2, 2025 is adjourned generally.
5. The defendant FHA and Matthew Wu's application for an order at paragraph 1 of the Notice of Application filed July 16, 2025 is adjourned generally on the basis that the plaintiff confirmed that he abandons the allegations at paragraph 23 of the Amended Notice of Civil Claim filed January 15, 2025 that he suffered loss of earnings, past and future or loss of pension benefits and entitlement, and seeks no damages in relation to those claims.
6. Costs of this application in the cause.
